There are ways to harvest wood and offer certified products that support responsible forest management and conservation through **Forest Stewardship Council (FSC)**. The **Chain-of-Custody** certification (COC) allows wood product to be tracked from a tree, through all stages of processing and production, and finally to its final form. By choosing these materials, institutions can meet standards for environmentally responsible construction or renovation rated by **LEED** green building rating system (**Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design**).



More certifications!

Palmieri is a participant of the Architectural Woodwork Institute that controls over the quality of materials, workmanship and installation. The rigorous inspection process is awarded with a Quality Certification that shows Palmieri's commitment to the finest quality furnishing standards in North America.



To ensure the stability, weight, durability and protection of the materials, and safety for individuals who use them, Palmieri is certified by Underwriters Laboratories that are specialized in safety testing.



Palmieri is approved by the General Services Administration that facilitates the furniture supplying process of all government federal agencies through state contracts and bids.



Since last year, Palmieri has a new competitively solicited contract with Educational and Institutional Cooperative Purchasing (E&I), a not-for-profit buying cooperative owned by its membership of more than 1500 tax-exempt colleges, universities, prep schools, hospitals, medical research institutions and hospital purchasing organizations located throughout the United States and Canada.



Besides the partnership with FSC, Palmieri is proud to be a member of American with Disabilities Act (ADA). Every piece throughout Palmieri's collections of library furniture is designed to accommodate and ensure equal opportunities for individuals with disabilities.

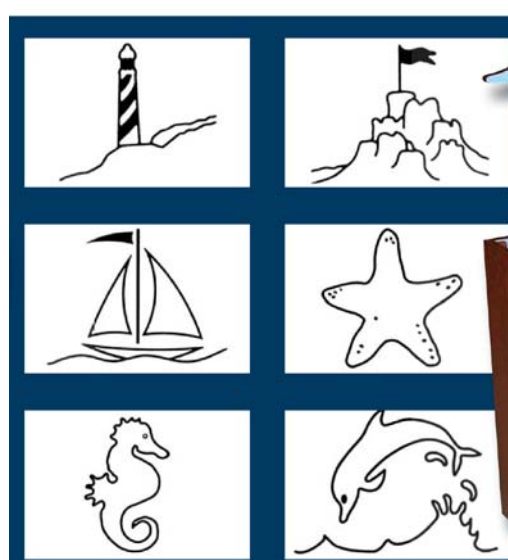
